09 days – 08 nights

Day 01 SANTIAGO - BALMACEDA – AYSÉN

Presentation at Caja Los Andes Central Offices, to begin transfer to the airport Arturo Merino Benítez, national gate area to board the scheduled flight with destination to Balmaceda. Reception at Balmaceda Airport and transfer to the city of Puerto Aysén. Arrival in the city of Coyhaique, making a sightseeing tour, Coyhaique Square, Los Colonos Park, The Shepherd Monument, having free time for lunch on passengers own. In the afternoon continue to travel to Puerto Aysén appreciating during the journey Valley Río Simpson, Salto de la Virgen, Queque Inglés and Poblado de Los Torreones. Arrival at Puerto Aysén appreciating Ibañez Bridge over the Aysén River, Puerto Aysén Square, Overlook of Puerto Viejo and the pier of La Balsa on Aysén river, accommodation in the Hotel Caicahue. Dinner and overnight.

Day 02 PUERTO AYSÉN - PUERTO ING. IBAÑEZ - CHILE CHICO

Breakfast. A time to be indicated, leave for the town of Puerto Ibañez in the south - east of Lago General Carrera to address the ferry to navigate the lake to the town of Chile Chico. (Depending on departure time if it were afternoon, lunch will be at Villa Castillo if shipment is in the early hours, lunch will be in Chile Chico), on the way can appreciate the wonderful landscape of ancient forests of fir, beech and tepas; land journey after boarding the ferry and after two hours of navigation, arrival in Chile Chico. This unique villa resort is known for its unique microclimate that allows you to cultivate a wide range of fruit trees including cherry trees. Depending on the season you can stay in the town of Los Antiguos, Argentina, just 8 miles away in which case it wouldn't take more than 01 hour between migration formalities and arrival to the town of Los Antiguos on the shore of Lake Buenos Aires Argentina, which is the Argentinean part of Lake General Carrera. Accommodation in Hostal Ventura, Chile Chico or at the Lodge Los Antiguos at the same location in Argentina. Dinner and overnight.



Day 03 – CHILE CHICO – COCHRANE

Breakfast. Early departure to the town of Cochran through a beautiful route that skirts the Lago General Carrera with a scenic landscape unmatched in the path called Paso de las Llaves, appreciating during the journey Puerto Guadal and heading to the village of Puerto Bertrand, having time to appreciate this unique town on the shores of Lago Plomo and from which is born the majestic Rio Baker. Lunch included. The trip continues in the afternoon, detouring in route to appreciate from a distance the Salton San Carlos and appreciate the wild herds of guanacos in the Estancia Chacabuco. La Estancia is now a private park with incredible wildlife: guanacos, wild ducks, foxes and eagles are possible to appreciate in its entire length. Continue to the town of Cochran, interesting town that lives off the cattle ranching. Accommodation in Don Carlos Inn or similar. Dinner and overnight.

Day 04 COCHRANE - PUERTO TORTEL - VILLA O'HIGGINS

Breakfast. Departure in a beautiful road that surrounds beautiful lakes, lagoons forests, streams and deep ravines. During the tour we will accompany the Baker River in his impetuous journey to the sea. On the way, we will visit Caleta Tortel where the uniqueness of this town whose narrow streets are pedestrian features that range in its entirety. Lunch at the site. Then continue the journey to Villa O'Higgins where you will arrive in the afternoon. Accommodation at Hostal Villa O'Higgins (note: given distance conditions the Hostel provides only the basic services, the passengers must take note that rooms are with shared bathroom). Dinner and overnight.

Day 05 VILLA O'HIGGINS

Breakfast. At time to be indicated transfer to Puerto Bahamondez to address vessel M/N Quetru sailing on Lake O'Higgins heading to the locality of Candelario Mansilla, place close to Laguna del Desierto notorious for the episode of Lieutenant Merino in defense of territory and was the scene of disagreements and arguments between Chile and Argentina. Departure. Lunch on board included based on a single dish. If the weather allows it, the trip to Laguna del Desierto will be replaced by a trip to navigate the Southern Ice Fields and the O'Higgins Glacier. The navigation is generally accompanied by rain and cold wind. The unique spectacle of ice giants tumbling between blue and gray torrents of noise will be the backdrop for the most spectacular whiskey of your life. Return to Villa O'Higgins. Dinner and overnight.

NOTE. IF NOT POSSIBLE FOR WEATHER CONDITIONS, EXCURSION WILL BE POSSIBLY MOVED TO NEXT DAY (DAY 06)



Day 06 VILLA O'HIGGINS – MAYER VALLEY

Breakfast. Free morning in Villa O'Higgins, can visit the town square and new church built next to the old building that the missionary priest Ronchi Angelo built in the past. Lunch included and in the afternoon half-day excursion for a visit to the Estancia Las Margaritas and Paso Entrada Mayer. Back to Villa. Dinner and overnight.

Day 07 VILLA O'HIGGINS - PUERTO TRANQUILO

Breakfast. Departure for the town of Puerto Tranquilo on the west bank of Lago General Carrera. In the return path we will cross aboard a barge the Michel Barge Fjord in the town of Puerto Bravo. To continue traveling directly to the Rio Baker Lodge for lunch and continue on the beautiful route by crossing La Pasarela Bridge, a place where the General Carrera Lake discharges its waters into the Bertrand Lake. Arrived in the afternoon to Puerto Tranquilo, accommodation at the Hostal Darka and / or Southern Road. Dinner and overnight.

Day 08 PUERTO TRANQUILO – COYHAIQUE

Breakfast. Departure to Coyhaique at time to be indicated by the tour coordinator. Previous to that we will sail across General Carrera Lake to visit the chapels and Marble Cathedral, appreciating the spectacular sight of the caves carved by the waves of the lake in the marble formations. Return to Puerto Tranquilo and departure to the destination of Villa Cerro Castillo. Lunch included. Free time to enjoy from this town the majestic Cerro Castillo. Continue to the city of Coyhaique appreciating during the trajectory Pampa de Balmaceda, Sierra Fozic and Cerro Mackay. Arrived to the Hotel Los Nires or similar. Rest of the day off. Dinner and overnight.

Day 09 COYHAIQUE - BALMACEDA - SANTIAGO

Breakfast. AT time to be indicated departure to the airport in Balmaceda to board your flight itinerary with destination Santiago. Arrival to Airport Comodoro Arturo Merino Benitez, reception and transfer to headquarters units Caja Los Andes.
